Must pre-register and be approved to enter.

Drivers Must be 18 years of age.

Requirements for ALL Burnout Contestants

1. SAFETY

- Helmet required. a minimum of a SNELL 2015 or better helmet.
- Neck Collar required.
- Fire suit required- SFI 3.2A/5 minimum.
- Seat belts/ harness required.
- Recommend fire retardant shoes, gloves, and head sock. Shoes must be closed toe.
- Firewall must be complete and without holes into the driver compartment.
- Scatter-shields required on supercharged entries using clutch. Ballistic transmission protection is required.
- Fireworks not permitted.

2. ENGINE

- Hot fluids must be contained under the hood or provisions must be made to contain hot fluid/ steam.
- No Nitromethane.
- No externally mounted Nitrous bottles.
- Two bolts must be placed in the exhaust pipe in a cross pattern within one inch of each other as close to turbo as
 is practical. Email events@ffl.com for special exceptions.

3. BATTERY

- Battery Disconnect Switch must be installed on all vehicles within easy reach for officials.
- Battery must be secured.

<u>4. BODY</u>

• Hatches, tailgate, wings, etc. must have additional tether.

5. WHEELS & TIRES

- No hubcaps/ wheel trim or wheel weights permitted.
- Wheels must be steel.

6. COMPETITION

- Burnout shall not begin until instructed by an event official.
- No standing burnouts, vehicle shall maintain movement.
- Driver must stop immediately if instructed by event staff.
- No passengers allowed in Open Class. Pro and Rivals Classes are allowed 1 passenger. The passenger must have all proper safety equipment just like the driver.
- Burnouts will be judged and limited to two minutes!
- Judging will be based upon- Instant smoke, constant smoke, volume of smoke, driving skill and use of the entire skid pad.
- Point deductions for wall contact resulting in damage or alteration to the pad layout.
- Any vehicle backing up will result in an automatic disqualification.
